The Environmental, Health and Safety Manager will provide overall leadership, strategy development and compliance assurance to all IBIS California facilities with respect to: (1) current and proposed safety, industrial hygiene, health and environmental regulations; (2) development and implementation of proactive safety, industrial hygiene, health and environmental activities which facilitate compliance, are cost effective and protect Ibis employee health, safety and the environment; (3) participate in the development of long range plans to address current and future occupational safety, health, and environmental issues facing all Abbott divisions and develops management and employee communications on these topics; (4) negotiation of compliance issues with regulatory agencies as necessary and track any response to citations/violations should they occur; (5) serves as a technical/regulatory resource in the areas of occupational safety, industrial hygiene, health or environmental compliance and the interpretation of analytical data to determine safety, industrial hygiene or environmental remediation control measures, etc; (6) project management relating to occupational safety and health investigations, all hazardous (chemical, biological and radioactive) waste disposal; (7) coordination of Ibis product safety and contractor safety programs. Knowledge of regulations and standards affecting IVDs and Biologics.

7-10 years experience in each of the following areas: operations experience in the assessment of regulatory compliance, development and identification of compliance and control strategies, and implementation of projects and programs; in depth knowledge of the requirements established by existing and proposed regulations pertaining to occupational safety, industrial hygiene, health or environmental legislation; liability issues relating to occupational safety/industrial hygiene and the environment; experience in submitting required documentation for necessary regulatory reviews and experience in evaluating the significance of analytical results for occupational safety, industrial hygiene, medical or environmental samples; risk assessment, experimental design and statistical methods; knowledge of training requirements established by existing regulations and experience in presenting appropriate training; project management, cost estimating, contract conditions and negotiations.
